The Kropdusters Car Club ([www.kropdusters.com](http://www.kropdusters.com)) are hosting the event with help and advice from friends, family, and car clubs from all over the Midwest, including the Vagabonds (from 7 states), The Rod Dippers (Missouri), Kerosene Kings (Iowa), Opossum Benders (Missouri), and the Chrome Czars (Illinois).

The Kropdusters [formerly Vertigo Car Club] was founded in 1995. In it's twelve years, many different interest were expressed by members of the club. Traditional hot rods and customs have always been at the for front. Now, they have chapters of there club in states all over the Midwest and the east coast. After attending and supporting many of the Midwest traditional car shows, they've decided it was time to host one of their own.

Thus, the Rust Revival was born!

The Rust Revival will be an action packed day full of activities, including plenty of live music, a pin stripers' panel jam, a flame throwing contest, and more!

With a pre show party on Friday night, things are sure to start off with a bang! The Rumble Jetts [KC MO] will be playing there energetic rockabilly tunes at MG'S Bar from 9:00p.m.-Midnight. Then Saturday's music kicks off at 11:00 am in the big tent right in the middle of it all. All music on sat will be outside on the stage... there will be two bands playing that are still TBA!!! Finally, closing the great weekend will an encore performance from the Rumble Jetts. They have toured with some of the biggest names in the rockabilly scene, including the Stray Kats. And they have also been featured on the CBS morning show. They are scheduled to play from 9:30p.m. -12:30a.m.

The Pin Stripers' Panel Jam will have pin stripers from all over the Midwest demonstrating a craft made popular by the likes of Von Dutch and Ed "Big Daddy" Roth. Proceeds from the sale of the pin stripers' art work will go to the local Awana Program [[www.awana.org](http://www.awana.org)]. The proceeds will help to provide for the funds needed to help for the 2008-09 session.

In order to keep that certain "traditional" look for the show, they have established a set of entry criteria for the show cars. Vehicles must be a 1964 or earlier hot rod or custom. This means no stock-appearing cars or anything billet that is visible. All vehicles must be driven to the show. Trailered cars will not be allowed, unless

**they are not street legal or finished.**

**Motor cycle's must be traditional looking chopper, bobbers, or vintage bikes. No art bikes, stock, [unless they are pre 1970], and no OCC style bikes of any kind.**

Scooters are allowed if they are older American and European scooters such as Cushman, Vespa, and the like.

All cars are subject to approval by staff the day of the show. Any cars that do not fit the criteria are more than welcome to park up the street and enjoy the activities planned for the event.

The Rust Revival is for all who enjoy the traditional hot rod and customs era. It is for everyone to get together and admire each others craftsmanship in the building of their cars. It is also a time for reunion of old friends and to simply have a great time.
